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


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


CHAPTER 1: THE CRY OF THE ICE


As the boat came closer, Mira called out, "Hello, is anyone here?"

Snowpaw looked at Mira and Leo with hope in his eyes. "The ice is crying for help," he said. "Will you join us? We need to work together."


Mira nodded. "Yes, we will help you. We are a team now."






Snowpaw frowned. "So humans are causing this?"


"The sea will rise so high that many cities will flood," Mira said. "We have to warn people."






"We have to show the world what's happening here," Mira said. "We need to stop this."
